This deck plan begins with deck 4. Deck 13 and decks 1 through 3 are not available to the public.

Deck 4 is the A Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 700 through 848. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator rooms that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

Deck 5 is the Main Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 500 through 698. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator rooms that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

Deck 6 is the Lower Promenade Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 300 through 423. It has two long hallways near the centerline of the ship and both are wheelchair accessible. To access the route along the perimeter of Deck 6, assistance with doors may be required. The floor contains three wheelchair-accessible elevator rooms that connect the inner hallways with the perimeter route.

Deck 7 is the Promenade Deck. A square-shaped, wheelchair-accessible route is available at the stern of the deck, and begins at the stern elevator room. A second wheelchair-accessible route begins in the center elevator room, and proceeds toward the bow of the deck. An accessible restroom is available near the center elevator room.

Deck 8 is the Upper Promenade Deck. A square-shaped, wheelchair-accessible route is available at the stern of the deck, and begins at the stern elevator room. This connects to a path around the interior of midship. At the foremost portion of the midship path, closer to port side, is one more path that allows for access to the remaining atrium, with one corridor on the starboard side to lead to the showroom. The wheelchair-accessible route can be reached from either of the two elevator rooms. An accessible restroom is available in the port side path at about midship.

Deck 9 is the Verandah Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 100 through 220. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The two elevator rooms that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible.

Deck 10 is the Navigation Deck and is comprised of Staterooms 001 through 065. It has two long hallways and both are wheelchair accessible. The three elevator rooms that connect the two hallways are also wheelchair accessible. A square-shaped, wheelchair-accessible route is available at the stern of the deck, and begins at the stern elevator room.

Deck 11 is the Lido Deck. A wheelchair-accessible route is available along the perimeter, one in a loop comprising the stern section of the deck, and a second loop connected to this path that goes around the midship. Two accessible restrooms are available: one aft portside, one at the end of a corridor at the foremost portion of the accessible route.

Deck 12 is the Sports Deck. A wheelchair-accessible route is available along the perimeter, starting from the aft-most portside portion to the deck, and going 3 quarters of the way around to terminate at the end of the midship starboard side of the deck. A corridor leads to a square-shaped route at the fore of the deck.

Deck 14 is the Sky Deck. No wheelchair-accessible routes are available on this deck.
